

He has performed more than 72,000 surgeries, including pioneering several firsts in Madhya Pradesh such as scleral-fix IOL, LASIK laser surgery, and advanced corneal treatments.

Access to Eye Care





Beneficiaries availed a range of eye care services through camps and mobile eye clinics.

RJCF served 58,916 beneficiaries across nine districts in the states of Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, and Uttar Pradesh in the Central Indian region.

Bringing Eye Care to the Doorstep.

The region of Central India remains one of the underserved regions in the country, especially for access to the healthcare services. Since the last three years, RCJF has delivered eye care services in select nine districts, totalling about 154,021 beneficiaries. This year the focus remained in conducting screening camps, providing surgical care, vision correction, and outreach through mobile clinics and community partnerships.



Screening Camps

Organizing free eye check-up camps in rural and underserved areas to detect cataract, glaucoma, retinal, corneal, and other vision problems.



Eye Surgery

Providing advanced eye surgeries, including cataract removal, glaucoma treatment, corneal transplants, and retinal procedures, at no cost to patients in need.





Nenuram Jatav, a 65-year-old daily wage laborer from Shivpuri, district in Madhya Pradesh had been the sole breadwinner for his family. Over time, his eyesight began to blur, making it increasingly difficult to work and support his loved ones. As his vision worsened, he feared losing not only his sight but also his livelihood.

Through local outreach efforts, Nenuram learned about Ratan Jyoti Charitable Foundation's free eye screening camps in Shivpuri. A detailed examination revealed cataracts in his eyes. He was referred to the hospital, where he underwent successful cataract surgery—completely free of cost. Today, Nenuram's vision is restored, and with it, his ability to work and live independently.

"After the operation, my eyesight has returned. I can now see clearly and work again. I am grateful to Ratan Jyoti and the medical team for giving me back my vision."




Foundation Impact




